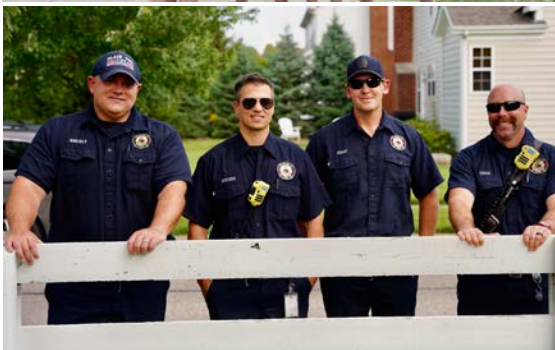
## New Management
